Synopsis: Remaining situationally aware includes having knowledge of weather basics. During disasters the weather plays a big role in many aspects of response. Being aware of the weather can help determine how your unit will respond or plan for an event; what, if any, weather hazards exist; if there are hazards on the horizon; and answer the question - will the weather contribute to the deterioration of the incident or provide relief. This class will teach you the advantages of watching the weather, finding avenues to monitor the weather, how to get weather forecasts, and knowing the weather hazards in your area.
